Sports Reports

- There was a general discussion of how the sports are operating.

- Baseball, Soccer. Football and Lacrosse who had hopes of offering team sports ended up refunding all the registrations fees.
- Football was particularly hard hit because of mandatory equipment servicing expenses regardless of whether they had a season or not.

Old Business

- 2020 Budget:
 - o There are some year-end expenses to be paid: Insurance for about \$1,800 and accounting for 2019 tax preparation.
 - O Softball will pay their per player fee at \$10 per player for their 90 or so players because they were able to have a softball season.
 - Canby Kids pays the electric bill for the Beck Well for Lee/Ackerman complex.
 Ryan Oliver volunteered to contact Canby School District to see if they would foot that bill for this year seeing that we were not able to use the field.
- 2021 budget:
 - Next year's sports ability to provide sports is unknown.
 - o The ability to have a poker fundraiser is unknown.
 - Shantel will contact Paula about the funds she has donated to go for the poker fundraiser seed money to see how she feels about taping into those funds for operating expenses while sports are unable to provide programs.

New Business

- Ryan Oliver volunteered to approach the city about supporting Canby Kids.
- Next meeting will be sometime in December at the Antonia Room.
- If CSD continues to restrict field usage and the city allows usage, the sports will need to work out field usage so the kids are able to have sports.
